School Uniform

As it is the start of a new school year, we have a couple of reminders regarding school uniform.

Our school uniform comprises of:

- Grey or black trousers/skirt/pinafore **no jeans or leggings**
- White polo shirt or polo top
- In the summer months, green gingham dresses or grey/black school shorts may be worn
- Bottle green sweatshirt or cardigan
- Black shoes or plain black trainers **no sandals**
- PE - white t-shirt, black shorts and black plimsolls. For outside P.E, leggings or track suit bottoms may be worn. Fleece and reversible coats, along with P.E. Bags, Book Bag and water bottles can also be purchased on the uniform websites.

It is school policy that no make-up or nail varnish or nail extensions are to be worn at any time. If your child comes to school wearing any of these, you will be contacted and may be called up to the school to remove them. Hair styles should be smart with no art work or bleaching.

Earrings are to be studs only, and on P.E. days must be removed. If your child cannot remove their earrings themselves, please make sure that they are removed before school. Teachers and other school staff are not permitted to remove them on your child's behalf, and your child will not be allowed to participate in P.E or sports if they cannot remove their earrings.

No other jewellery is to be worn to school at any time. This is for Health and Safety reasons. If your child is required to wear jewelry for religious reasons, please speak to a member of the school office or Headteacher.

Children are required to have a PE kit in school, it stays in school until half term when it is sent home to be washed.

There will be a school uniform policy sent out at the end of September.

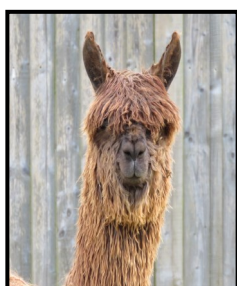

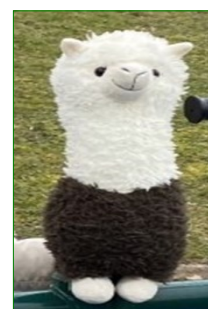
