

Year 6 Trip to Haslemere Mueseum

On Tuesday Gorillas class went to Haslemere Education Museum to learn about Ancient Greece. The children were focusing on the myths that we have been learning about in English, in particular 'The twelve labours of Heracles'. Haslemere museum provided a background to Ancient Greek theatre where we were able to learn a script, create some authentic Ancient Greek masks and perform in front of the historic Pantheon. The children were a credit to us and thoroughly enjoyed the experience.
