- * Christmas lunch followed by afternoon school disco

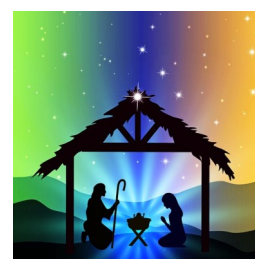


Nativity performances for Year R, 1 & 2

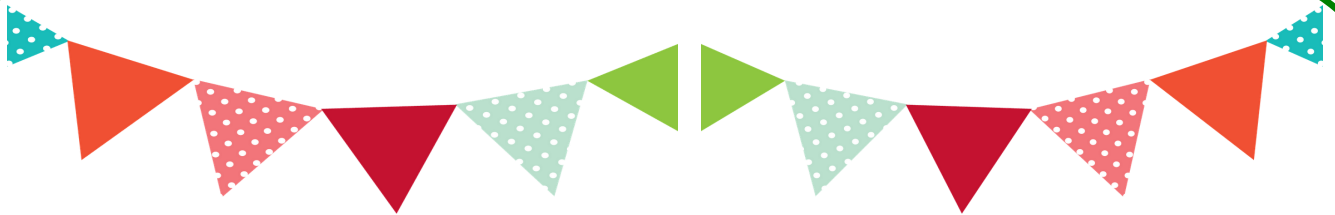
