- \* Christmas lunch followed by afternoon school disco

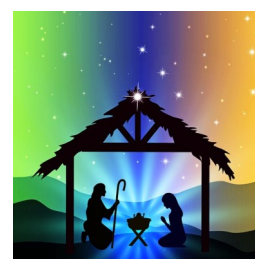


## Nativity performances for Year R, 1 & 2

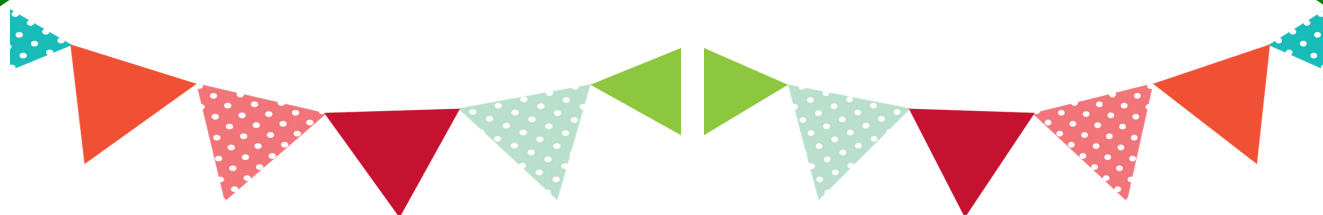
