**Thursday 14th December:** Christmas lunch followed by afternoon school disco, you can wear normal clothes or a Christmas jumper if you have one.




## Nativity performances for Year R, 1 & 2

As the days are getting colder please can children bring a coat to school. They are welcome to bring in hats and gloves but please can all clothing be clearly labelled with your child's name.






