Safeguarding Information for Parents & Carers

Safeguarding at Woodcroft

Safeguarding the pupils of Woodcroft is our number one priority. It is the legal responsibility of individuals that work in schools to safeguard pupils. If a child makes a disclosure that may mean they are at risk of harm or have suffered harm, we must report this to Children's Services. As a school, we do not decide what steps are then taken, this responsibility sits with Children's Services or the Police.

What should you do if you suspect a child may be at risk of harm?

Although school staff have a legal responsibility to protect children, we should all raise concerns if we suspect a child may be at risk. Anyone can do this and it can be anonymous.

If you believe a child is in immediate danger then you should call the police. If you have concerns that a child is at risk, but not in an immediate danger then you can make a referral to children's services directly.

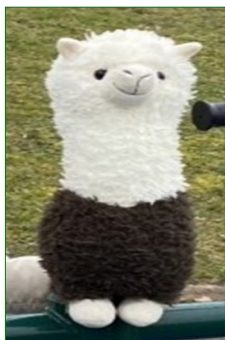

Mobile dental service for people experiencing health inequalities

This service is for people who:

Live in Hampshire or the Isle of Wight

and

Don't already have a dentist either NHS or private

and

Are exempt from paying NHS dental charges

or

Are facing health inequalities that make it difficult to access treatment

What do you mean by health inequalities?

This includes families experiencing poverty and social deprivation, people experiencing or at risk of homelessness, looked after children, people who are supported by our partner charities and people who are referred to us by our partner organisations.



What treatment can I have?

Dental and oral cancer screening

Extractions

Oral health advice

Preventative care

Dental care for children

Emergency care

Fillings

What do I do next?

Call Dentaid The Dental Charity on 023 8001 4450 to make an appointment.

Important information

This service is a partnership between Dentaid The Dental Charity and NHS Hampshire and Isle of Wight to provide dental care for people facing health inequalities and those exempt from paying NHS charges, including children and new and expectant mothers. Only people who meet our eligibility criteria will be offered appointments. This service does not include cosmetic procedures such as teeth whitening.

Appointments are required and you must be able to arrive at least 15 minutes ahead of your appointment time.
