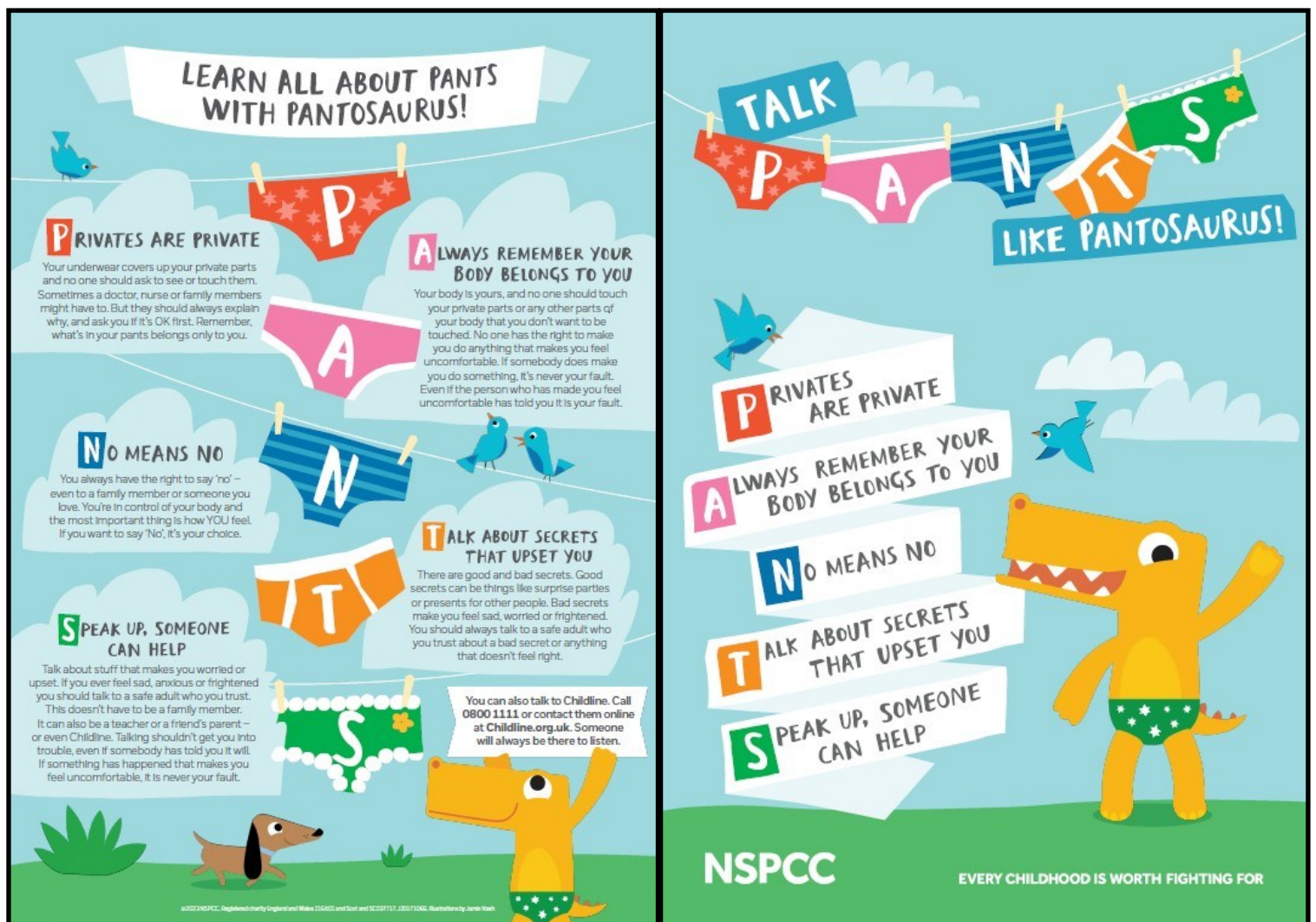
Pantosaurus Song
