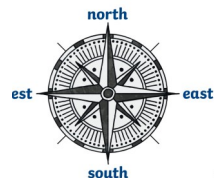
### What should I already know?

### Where Is Antarctica?



Antarctica is the area of land that is the furthest south in the world. It contains the South Pole. It is the coldest place on Earth.



A **compass** has four main directions, which are north, east, south and west. Part of the **compass** (the needle) will always point north. You then have to work out which **direction** you are facing depending on where north is.

A desert is a place where it is normally very hot and dry during the day, and sometimes very cold at night. Normally it has a lot of sand or rocks and hardly ever rains.










### Knowledge:

## Continents and Oceans



continent		One of the earth's large land masses.
ocean		A very large stretch of sea, one of five oceans of the world.
country		A political unit or state on a national scale.
equator		The imaginary line around the earth's surface equidistant from the north and south pole.
compass		Is a tool for finding direction.
north		The direction to the right of a person facing the rising sun.
south		The direction to the right of a person facing the rising sun.
