Safeguarding at Woodcroft

Safeguarding the pupils of Woodcroft is our number one priority. It is the legal responsibility of individuals that work in schools to safeguard pupils. If a child makes a disclosure that may mean they are at risk of harm or have suffered harm, we must report this to Children's Services. As a school, we do not decide what steps are then taken, this responsibility sits with Children's Services or the Police.

What should you do if you suspect a child may be at risk of harm?

Although school staff have a legal responsibility to protect children, we should all raise concerns if we suspect a child may be at risk. Anyone can do this and it can be anonymous. ***If you believe a child is in immediate danger then you should call the police.*** If you have concerns that a child is at risk, but not in an immediate danger then you can make a referral to children's services directly.
