- To use an atlas to locate The UK on a world map.

Fieldwork:

- To visit a beach to observe it's features (touching the sand) draw a field sketch.
- To use simple observations to compare West Wittering Beach with 3 other beaches (Portsmouth Harbour, Southsea, Australian beach).
- To ask simple questions about beaches (eg. why do some have sand and others shingle?)

Music: Walking the Dog

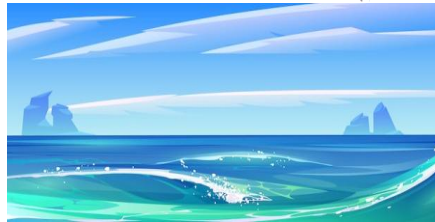
Dimensions Focus: duration and structure

Science: Seasons Do seasons affect plants and plants?

- There are four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter.
- Animals and plants have adapted ways of surviving the changing seasons.
- These include hibernating, storing food, fattening up, migration, loss of leaves.
- Trees can be either evergreen or deciduous.
- Evergreen trees keep their green leaves all year round.
- Deciduous trees lose their leaves every autumn.

Drawing-

Painting-
